

Work on WEP-3 may start this year

Source says that the third line of westeast gas transmission project would hopefully begin construction this year. It possibly runs from Xinjiang to Fujian Province, covering 10 provinces and cities in China. Some pipes are in parallel with the second line of the west-east gas transmission project. Plus, the gas also comes from the Central Asia. It is also rumored that the 3rd line may be divided into the west section (from Korgas in Xinjiang to Zhongwei City in Ningxia) and the east section (from Zhongwei City in Ningxia to Fujian Province), covering several provinces, autonomous regions and cities including Xinjiang, Gansu, Shaanxi, Henan, Hubei, Hunan and Fujian. But such saying is yet to be confirmed by China National Petroleum Corporation (CNPC). China has built two gas pipe lines for the west-east gas transmission project. The first line starts from Tarim of Xinjiang and ends at Shanghai.
